Exciting new FREE training courses at Wallsend People's Centre

new short courses for people trying to get back into work

Wallsend People's Centre is introducing some short courses in the New Year for people who are preparing to find employment.

As part of our Passport to Employment initiative, we will be linking attendees to potential employers in the area, particularly in the care, retail and construction sectors. We are also providing an IT/Admin course for those seeking work in an office environment.

- The Retail, Care and IT/Admin courses will be over 2 days in January 2007. Each of these courses will consist of five hours a day over two consecutive days. Those successfully completing the course will be awarded a certificate of achievement.
- The Construction Industry course will be over 4 days in February 2007 and those successfully completing the course will be awarded the Construction Site Safety Certificate (CSSC).
- For all of these courses we will provide lunch, bus/metro fares and help with childcare.
- The courses are specifically aimed at people who are trying to find a job and will focus on skills linked to jobs in the care sector and the retail sector.

The provisional dates are:

- Care (including handling, food hygiene and control of hazardous substances) Mon and Tues 22nd and 23rd January
- IT/Admin Wed and Thurs 24th and 25th January
- Retail (including basic computer skills) Tues and Wed 30th and 31st January
- Construction Site Safety Certificate Mon and Tue 5th and 6th Feb
