You could qualify for a grant which could help keep you warm this winter.

At the event you will receive information about making your home warmer and more energy efficient with a grant from the Government's **Warm Front Scheme**.

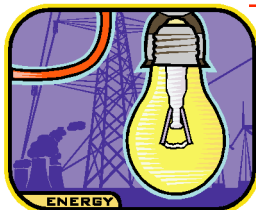
Under the Warm Front scheme, which is government funded, home-owners and private tenants who receive certain benefits could be eligible for a grant of up to £2,700 to help pay for central heating and home insulation.

Measures available to qualifying households include:

- **loft insulation, cavity wall insulation, draught proofing;**
- **energy saving light bulbs, central heating;**
- **boiler repairs and replacements**

Those likely to be eligible for a grant are people over 60, householders with a child under 16, pregnant mothers with a MAT B1 certificate and people suffering from disabilities or a long-term illness.

Homeowners and private tenants who are aged 60, or over, and who are not in receipt of a Warm Front qualifying benefit may also be eligible for £300 towards the cost of a heating system under the new **Warm Front £300 Rebate Scheme**.



We also have a limited number of energy efficient light bulbs to give away each day on a first come first serve basis.
